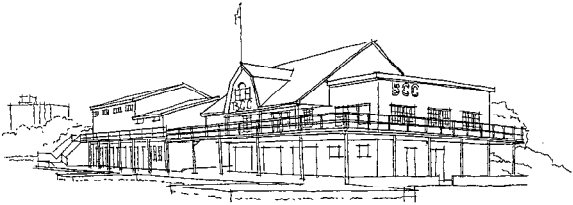


WELCOME TO 2008 Banook CANOE CLUB

MEMBERSHIP—

GENERAL INFORMATION

Membership at Banook is limited to family memberships or those individuals who are 15 or older. Children under the age of twelve are to be supervised at the club at all times and a babysitter is allowed with a family membership pending approval by the club manager. This person must be 16 or older and will not have club privileges.

A basic [membership](#) entitles all members to visit the club, swim in a supervised environment and take out the club recreational canoes.

Use of the racing boats at Banook is restricted to adults or those individuals who are registered in a paddling program. Fees are determined by age classification. There will be no refund of fees.

A FAMILY [MEMBERSHIP](#) includes two parents/guardians and **all dependent** children living at the same address. A babysitter can be included with this membership at no additional charge. Additional charges apply for paddling programs. Cost is \$450. This fee includes HST.

AN [INDIVIDUAL MEMBERSHIP](#) is avail-

able to anyone over the age of 15. Cost is \$240. This fee includes HST.

A **WAR CANOE MEMBERSHIP** is available to students **over the age of 17**. This is a special summer membership to those students who want to do **war canoe/K-4/C-4** only during the summer. Cost is \$200 which includes CCA registration.

A **SOCIAL MEMBERSHIP** is available to individuals over 25 who want to visit and support the club. The cost is \$50 per person. There is no paddling access or boat storage with this membership.

BOAT STORAGE

Space is available at the club for storage of personal boats. Cost is \$75 per boat. Storage is at your own risk and you should provide your own lock and insurance. Space is limited and at the paddling committee discretion.

FUN-RAISING COMMITMENT

A [fun-raising commitment](#) is required. Fun-raising credits can be earned by volunteering or participating in a variety of events throughout the year.
